



## Fast Facts

The Eagan Resource Center is a nonprofit organization committed to eliminating hunger in Dakota County. ERC has grown from serving 38 families per month in 2005 to serving 448 families per month in 2009.

### Fast Facts

- Of the people we serve:
  - 52% live in Eagan
  - 40% live in Burnsville
  - 8% live in Apple Valley and Rosemount
  - 51% of the people we serve are adults
  - 49% are children
- In 2009, ERC served more than 2,000 new individuals.
- Pounds of food distributed per year:
  - 2007 – 161,759
  - 2008 – 296,326
  - 2009 – 383,608

ERC distributes fresh produce and meat in addition to non-perishables.

The Eagan Resource Center relies on the generosity of hundreds of people who donate time, food and money to the ERC. This year, nearly 400 volunteers have contributed more than 8,700 hours of time to the organization.
