

Eagan Resource Center Garden to Table Adopt-A-Garden Guidelines

1. Participants may garden at their own convenience daily from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm. No gardening will be conducted outside this time frame.
2. The garden is intended for personal use only. Gardening for commercial purposes is not allowed.
3. Pets are not allowed in the garden area. Children in the garden area must be supervised at all times.
4. Garden plot participants are expected to keep their plots clear and free of weeds, grass, and other debris that can harbor insects. Weeds over 6" in height or weeds with seed heads must be removed. Gardens left unattended will be considered abandoned and will be reassigned.
5. Weeds, cuttings and other debris from your garden plot must be removed at each visit, *separated* and taken to the designated area supplied by the Eagan Resource Center. Absolutely no dumping of debris into other garden plots is allowed.
6. Garden plots are to be used to grow vegetables, fruits or herbs. Illegal plants of any kind are not allowed.
7. Crops, plants, vines and vegetation must be contained within the boundaries of one's garden plot. Overlapping onto adjacent pathways or garden plots is prohibited.
8. No fertilizers or insecticides will be used that will detrimentally affect adjacent plots or grass. Only organic fertilizers will be allowed. Herbicides are not allowed.
9. Structures, other than trellis for vines and melons, are not allowed in the community garden.
10. Garden tools will be provided by ERC. One water spigot and rain barrel will be supplied by the Eagan Resource Center for the entire garden to utilize. Buckets will be supplied for your use. Hoses may not be used.
11. All crops must be harvested by the end of October or will be destroyed.
12. All non-compostable materials must be removed by the end of October or will be destroyed.
13. Disruptive behavior, profanity, and/or use of alcohol, tobacco or other drugs are prohibited on the property of the Eagan Resource Center.
14. The Eagan Resource Center and affiliates assume no liability for any injury, damage, theft or loss of property belonging to garden user participants, before, during, or after their usage and/or lease.
15. Gardeners agree to comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Eagan Resource Center may terminate a garden plot lease or activity at any time for non-compliance.
